L'esortazione apostolica Vita consecrata definisce la scelta dei monaci e delle monache una delle «tracce che la Trinità lascia nella storia perché gli uomini possano avvertire il fascino e la nostalgia della bellezza». A distanza di due decenni dalla pubblicazione di quel documento è necessario prendere atto dei problemi, provocati principalmente da un'errata interpretazione del rinnovamento promosso e auspicato dal Vaticano II. Proprio dal Concilio è necessario ripartire. E, in particolare, da tre fondamentali acquisizioni. La prima è la teologia della Parola, con un convinto ritorno alla vita spirituale, carenza individuata tra le principali cause della sterilità odierna della vita consacrata. La seconda è la teologia di comunione, intesa come apertura a spazi di relazione e rilettura dei carismi nella situazione attuale, anche al fine di individuare e soccorrere povertà ignorate o disattese. La terza, infine, è la teologia delle realtà terrestri, il ritorno alla grande tradizione dei padri della Chiesa, al tempo in cui i monaci lavoravano, pregavano e vivevano il loro battesimo a stretto contatto con gli altri battezzati.

È dedicato ai "dialoghi teologici internazionali", che coinvolgono Chiese od organismi di Chiesa sovranazionali e mettono in gioco le grandi tradizioni cristiane: il luteranesimo, il calvinismo, l'anglicanesimo, il cattolicesimo, l'ortodossia. I documenti di consenso sui vari argomenti affrontati rappresentano dunque il cammino verso l'accordo tra i vari rami in cui il cristianesimo si è diviso.

From the Author: My God is kind, compassionate, merciful, and he loves me. Yet, there are questions that arise; there are accounts of God that seem contradictory to my simplicity, and there are accusations against God that can leave me struggling for an explanation. At times I’ve been confused by the concept of God’s love and the reality of life, and there often existed a dichotomy between the two. I wrote this book after numerous conversations with friends who, regardless of their spiritual journey have experienced similar thoughts, or have simply ignored some of the hard questions of life and faith. Common

societal thinking in many areas is moving towards a position where people regard God as an outdated fairy-tale with a sinister undertone leading to apathy or resentment towards God. This is far removed from my notion of a living and loving God who is kind, compassionate and merciful. Embarking on my personal journey of discovering God's reputation, I have a hunch that I'm not alone. I need to explore God and find comfort with the answer. Would you join me on this journey of discovery? Maybe all the dots haven't been joined, and some of the joined dots remain open to interpretation, yet the line I've used to join the dots is what I know of the underlying nature and character of God.

### **Filosofia e teologia**

Il fascino della figura di Gesù ha catturato l'inquietudine degli uomini e delle donne di tutti i tempi. La sua persona conquista, ma suscita anche dubbi e rifiuti perché sembra sfuggire all'indagine della sola ragione. Non va colto semplicemente il "dato" di quest'uomo nel contesto storico, ma occorre sondare il suo ineffabile mistero "rivelato" alla storia. Il volume non presenta una vita di Gesù, ma sviluppa una riflessione sull'evento "Gesù" come novità che scompone le categorie umane e introduce alla rivelazione del mistero di Gesù che è la via, la verità e la vita, l'Unico che, nello Spirito Santo, ci rivela il Padre. Non si tratta solo di imparare da Cristo, ma di imparare Lui che è «il mediatore e la pienezza di tutta la rivelazione».

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
